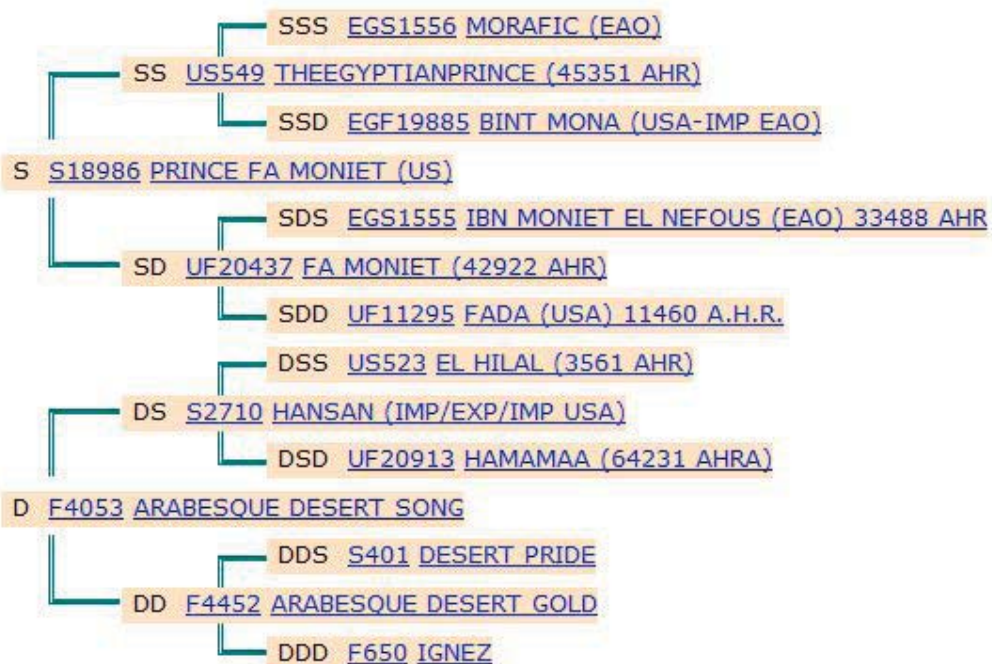

### **Halimas Desert Princess F 23036**

X Prince Fa Moniet (Imp USA) Deceased. Leased from Ansata Egyptian Stud, USA

This beautiful mare is out of Forest Hill Stud's grand matriach Arabesque Desert Song who was sired by one of the first Straight Egyptian stallions to be imported to Australia, Hansan, a son of El Hilal. Hansan was imported from the USA, became one of Australia's greatest show stallions of his era, and became one of the most successful sires of his time. Hansan was eventually re-exported back to the USA where he became the back up stallion in the El Hilal Syndicate. Hansan was chosen as he was the most influential El Hilal Straight Egyptian stallion alive at the time. Hansan's influence on Australian Arabian breeding was immense. Halimas Princess Annaomition is one of only a handful of daughters of the legendary Prince Fa Moniet in Australia. Arabesque Desert Song is the dam, granddam and greatgranddam of some of the most successful show and breeding Arabians in Australia including Australian National Arabian Champion Mare and winners of major shows Australia wide. This lovely grey mare is approximately 15HH and has a very sweet temperament. Halimas Desert Princess has only been lightly bred. Her first foal, a colt by Sanadik Ibn Estopa (Imp USA) named Halimas Sanson has been sold to Malyasia where he has been enthusiastically accepted and is breeding many mares. The second foal born was a beautiful bay Filly by Fayrid (Imp USA) named Halimas Fantasia who has been shown once for a win in the yearling filly class at the 2008 NSW State Titles.
